

Etwall Village Hall Improvements - Consultation

The old pavilion area of the building was constructed in the early 1970's and the extended hall opened in 1990. Apart from some redecoration, there has been no improvement work carried out in the old pavilion and toilet area. As a result the facilities are not suitable for the 2020s and do not appeal to potential users.

Etwall Parish Council has obtained funding towards the cost of refurbishment and improvements to the toilets and provision of a meeting room with drinks station, which is required to meet demand for additional facilities.

In order to complete the works, additional funding in the form of a loan is required and this consultation is to seek parishioner's views. Further details and a copy of the display are attached and we would be grateful if you could review these and give your consent to the loan on the attached voting slip. Returns must be received by Friday 3rd January.
