- 387 **Apologies for Absence** – Cllr Bilbie, Cllr Sandhu, Cllr Patten
- 388 **Declaration of Interests** – None
- 389 **Minutes of the Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> March** – These had already been agreed as a true and accurate record and signed by the Chairman.
- 390 **Matters Arising** - None
- 391 **Public Participation** – No members of the public present
- 392 **Election of Chairman** – Cllr Bennett was unanimously elected Chairman.
- 393 **Election of Vice-Chairman** – Cllr Fox was unanimously elected Vice-Chairman.
- 394 **Review of Provision of Pay Telephone** – Cllr Bennett reported that no-one had used the telephone to make outgoing calls in the previous quarter. Cllr Ireland suggested that the line be used to install broadband to allow remote access to the CCTV and it was decided to obtain prices for this. Regular users of the hall to be asked if they ever used the telephone. A decision to be postponed to the next meeting when more information would be available.
- 395 **Use of the Frank Wickham Hall by the Almshouses** – The question was asked, if there was an emergency at the Almshouses could the tenants be looked after in the village hall. The church was also being asked the same question. It was felt that if there were any emergency within the village it was hoped that the village hall would be available. A letter to be sent to the Almshouses to confirm this.
- 396 **Any Other Business**
- (a) There had been a problem during a letting when the piano key was not available. The Booking Clerk had now identified the piano key and was to ask if anyone needed the piano when making a booking.

- (b) There was a problem at the hall when the water boiler was not sufficient and kettles were used as well. This blew a fuse and it was difficult to obtain a key to gain access to the boiler room. The Clerk to arrange for the electricians to be checked and the Village Halls Service to be asked if stand-alone water boilers were allowed. If so prices to be obtained.
- (c) A list of all hall key holders to be compiled.
