- 386 **Apologies for absence** – Cllr Warburton, Cllr Whitehouse and Cllr Kirke
- 387 **Declaration of interests** – All members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of the Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest.
- 388 **Minutes of the meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017** – Already approved at full Council meeting.
- 389 **Public speaking** – None
- 390 **Christmas Tree Lights Update** – Cllr Neal offered to draw up a specification for the electrical works for forwarding to the church to allow for their approval to connect to their supply. It was suggested that a meeting of the sub-committee be held early in the New Year.
- 391 **106 Monies – Highway Works** – Cllr Neal reported that he was meeting a contractor representative on site to obtain quotations for the resurfacing of the two footpaths and the provision of a path on King George V Playing Field should funding be available. DCC Highways maintenance have also been requested to quote for the works. The Clerk to advise the Cricket Club that works to the adjacent footpath would be taking place.
- 392 **Bus Stop Outside Newsagents** – Letters had been sent to all the properties between Steve’s Fish Bar and the bend in the road on Main Street consulting on the installation of a bus stop. One negative verbal reply had been received but this would be put in writing. Any replies to the consultation would be sent to DCC with the agreement for Etwall Parish Council to carry out future maintenance in order for DCC to decide where the bus stop should be sited.
- 393 **Planning Applications for Consideration** –  
9 2017 1140 - The erection of an extension at 75 Egginton Road – No objections.
- 394 **Street Naming and Numbering Consultation – Land off Ladybank Road, Micklover** – No objections. It was suggested that names from the Etwall war memorial could be used for any future developments in Etwall.
- 395 **Any Other Business** – It was reported that the street name plate for Ivan Way had been installed.
