411 **Apologies for absence** – Cllrs Whitehouse, Ireland and Smith

412 **Declaration of interests** – All members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of the Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest.

413 **Public speaking** – A discussion took place on the revised planning application for the erection of 11 dwellings on land to the rear of 8-10 Lawn Avenue.

414 **Planning applications to be considered:-**

- (a) The erection of a detached dwelling to the rear and creation of parking to the front of 5 Windmill Road – OBJECTION – The Parish Council did not wish to see new dwellings in rear garden developments.
- (b) The erection of an agricultural livestock building on land at SK 2732 5659 Main Street – NO OBJECTION
- (c) Erection of an extension at 3 Pine Close – NO OBJECTIONS
- (d) Lawn Avenue the general wording of a supplementary letter was agreed with the addition of reference to number of dustbins if road extension is not adopted and hence dust cart stops on existing road.

It was noted that approval had been received to site a container on Sandypits Lane Playing Field.

415 **Highway Issues**

- (a) It was agreed that Cllr Payton could approach the landowner regarding the gift of land for improvements to Burnaston Lane.
- (b) The Chair informed the committee of Highways England’s proposals for the A38 Derby junction.

416 **Lighting of tree on village green for Christmas** – It was reported that there had been a further delay regarding the supply of electricity from the church. There was a proposal from the sub-committee to erect the lights with a temporary “extension lead” from the church – the aim was still to have the lights erected for 11/11/18.

- 417 **Siting of Lamp Post Poppies** – The Chair proposed the following locations –  
Main Street - east of Egginton Road to Sutton Lane,  
Egginton Road to Chestnut Grove to Main Street  
Willington Road to Kiln Croft  
Oaklands Road as far as Belfield Road
