The Pride of Etwall Awards – Award Guidelines

The Pride of Etwall Awards were introduced by Etwall Parish Council to recognise the outstanding efforts of individuals who make a positive contribution to life in Etwall.

The Parish Council acknowledge that many individuals work hard, often without reward to provide a healthy and thriving community within Etwall. The Pride of Etwall Awards go some way in recognising and rewarding those efforts whilst also providing inspiration for other who may also want to contribute in the same way.

Nominations should recognise the contributions an individual has made to Etwall, it's residents and community spirit. Please include as much detail as possible within your nomination/s.

Nominees and individuals nominated do not have to live within Etwall. However, to receive an award an individual's efforts and contributions must, in some way benefit the community of Etwall.

Everyone is welcome to make a nomination for the Pride of Etwall Awards. You can nominate more than one individual if you wish. Only one nomination per person should be made by an individual.

You cannot nominate yourself for an award.

Etwall Parish Council will advertise via the noticeboards, through Facebook posts and within meeting minutes when the nomination period is open.

Nomination/s must be made by the date given by Etwall Parish Council. Any nominations made after the date may not be considered.

You may nominate an individual for a posthumous award.

Pride of Etwall nominations are received by the Parish Council Clerk and presented, anonymously to the Parish Council to facilitate a vote.

The Parish Council would normally allow up to 3 individual awards each year.

Individuals can be nominated and awarded a Pride of Etwall award more than once if deemed appropriate by the Parish Council.

The winner/s of the Award/s will be notified by post or email and invited to a Parish Council meeting to receive their certificate. All details will remain confidential and only the Clerk will have access to names, email address and postal addresses.

Individuals who receive an Award will have their names printed onto the Pride of Etwall boards, displayed at Frank Wickham Hall.
