- 12/6/2999 **Apologies for Absence** – Cllr P Bilbie and Cllr K Rushby  
12/6/2300 **Declaration of Interests** – All Members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of the Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest. Cllr Muller and Cllr Cresswell declared an interest as allotment holders.  
12/6/2301 **Suggestions for possible future major projects in Etwall** – Cllr Cresswell explained that when large planning applications were made anywhere in the South Derbyshire area, local communities were often recompensed by way of improving local facilities. The Parish Council were looking at possible major projects which could be put forward should any funding become available in the future.

The attached list of ideas was circulated and the following ideas were added:-

- (a) Scout Hut
- Extension to building
  - Disabled toilet
  - Refurbishment to include new heating and rewiring
  - New roof
- (b) Frank Wickham Hall
- Addition of a stage and changing rooms
  - Addition of a mezanine level

Clerk to contact Mr Bown to ask for a rough idea of costings.

A further suggestion was received from members of the public which was to replace the existing white posts in the area of the church with some more attractive posts and refurbish the chains. It was felt that this was something that could be done by normal Parish Council funding and investigations were to be made with the Conservation Officer as to what would be acceptable.

IT WAS DECIDED to put forward the extension of the Frank Wickham Hall and the refurbishment works to the Scout Hut to South Derbyshire District Council.
