- 367 **Apologies for Absence** – Cllr Muller, Cllr Patten
- 368 **Declaration of Interest** – All Members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of the Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest. Cllr Cresswell was also an allotment holders.
- 369 **Minutes of meeting held on 16th July 2012** – These had already been approved and signed at a full council meeting.
- 370 **Public Speaking** – None
- 371 **Request from Scouts to acquire Sandypits Lane Changing Rooms** – Members felt that it would be a good idea to rent this building to the Scouts for storage in the same way as the adjacent building was rented to the Pigeon Club. IT WAS DECIDED that a meeting be arranged with representatives of the Scouts on site to discuss the proposals in more detail. An annual rent of £100 was suggested (the same as the Pigeon Club).
- 372 **Items for inclusion in budgets 2012/13** – It was felt that an amount should be included in the budgets for hanging baskets. Cllr Patten had ascertained the hanging baskets could only be put on metal not concrete posts. Costs of inspections were still being investigated.
- 373 **Planting of Bulbs** – The bulbs had been ordered and Cllr Warburton was to discuss the planting with John Port School and/or the Scouts.
- 374 **Allotments Update** – A meeting had been arranged with the Allotment Association at the allotments at 7.00 pm on Tuesday 25th September.
- 376 **Any Other Business** – Cllr Warburton mentioned that her father had a line marker in his garage. If this were not wanted by Egginton Parish Council it was to be offered to the Etwall football team.
