- 418 **Apologies for absence** – Cllr Patten and Cllr Sandhu
- 419 **Declaration of interests**- All members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest.
- 420 **Election of Chairman** – Cllr Day was nominated, seconded and unanimously elected Chairman.
- 421 **Election of Vice-Chairman** – Cllr Warburton was nominated, seconded and unanimously elected Vice-Chairman.
- 422 **Minutes of the meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2014** – Already approved at full Council meeting
- 423 **Public Speaking** - Mr Harrison of Etwall Bowls Club explained the quotations that he had obtained for the repair/reinforcement of the bowling green storage building.
- 424 **Finance** –
- (a) Quotations for the repair of the storage shed – IT WAS DECIDED to accept a quotation from B T Bate to carry out this work as per the quotation at a cost of £300. Should top fixings be required these would be added at a later date.
- 425 **Review of Access to the Bowling Green** – The existing access was explained and alternative options were discussed. Cllr Day to look at the different options in detail and report back.
- 426 **CCTV in the Area of the Public Toilets** – In view of the recent incidents of vandalism in the village, particularly in and around the public toilets, the Police had suggested that CCTV be installed in that area. As the public toilets were owned by SDDC and the library and school in the same area were owned by DCC, it was suggested that the Parish Council write to these authorities and ask if they would be willing to provide CCTV.
- 427 **Any Other Business**
- (a) Cllr Payton reported that he had contacted the Primary School and the clothing bank would be re-sited. The Clerk to inform the PT Groundsman.

- (b) It was felt that the hedge on the drive leading to the Frank Wickham Hall needed to be trimmed. The Clerk to write to the owner.
- (c) A large branch on a tree behind the public toilets had broken and was hanging over the footpath. Contractors were asked to remove the branch. As there were a number of dead branches they had suggested that a tree survey be carried out. SDDC were to be asked to carry out a tree survey again.
