- 527 **Apologies for absence** – Cllrs Warburton and Muller
- 528 **Declaration of interests**- All members of Etwall Parish Council attending this meeting, being automatically Trustees of Frank Wickham Hall Charity, declared their interest. Cllr Kirke declared an interest as an allotment holder.
- 529 **Minutes of the meeting held on 22nd January 2018** – Approved at Full Council meeting.
- 530 **Public Speaking** - None
- 531 **Allotments** –
- (a) Security fence – It was reported that a security fence of 2m or less did not require planning permission although permission would be required from Severn-Trent as landowners. The Parish Council could apply for planning permission without incurring fees. It was felt that this would be extremely expensive and the Parish Council did not have funds to finance it. It was suggested that some funding could come from Safer Neighbourhoods.
 - (b) Secure Place for Storage of Equipment – Planning permission would also be required to site a storage container which would have to be black or green and permission would be required from Severn Trent as landowners. It was felt that it would be difficult to get the container onto the area suggested due to the distance from the roadway. There was also insufficient funding in the Parish Council’s budget for a container.
 - (c) New Allotment Agreement – One tenant had objected to clause 8 but as this was a standard clause from the document provided by DALC. IT WAS THEREFORE DECIDED that it should remain.
 - (d) Security Camera – Members were asked if a security camera could be installed. The Parish Council felt that this was impractical due to its remote location and the rules connected with installation of cameras.
- 532 **Football – Sandypits Lane** – IT WAS DECIDED to offer the football team the pitch and changing facilities at King George V Playing Field for the forthcoming season whilst the provision of new changing facilities at Sandypits were being investigated. IT WAS DECIDED to make a bid for 106 monies for new changing facilities. There was currently interest in one adult and four junior Etwall teams. The team was willing to apply for grants and raise funds for improved facilities at Sandypits. Parish Council to investigate the purchase of new goalposts.

- 533 **Review of agreement with East Midlands Reserve Forces and Cadets Association use of land to site building on Sandypits Lane Playing Field** – An email had been sent with the Parish Council’s suggestion for an increase in ground rent. No reply had yet been received.
- 534 **106 monies** – A list to be drawn up of projects to be submitted to SDCC prior to a meeting. This was to be done as a matter of urgency.
- 535 **Date of next meeting** – To be decided.
