To consider the following:

- a) Purchase of bench(es) and/or picnic table(s)

RESOLVED to recommend the purchase of 3 benches (one of which will be a bench for the jubilee) and 2 picnic tables with seats at a cost of £3,490 excluding VAT and delivery.

Clerk to get quotes for slabs to be placed under benches.

- b) Outdoor gym equipment and grant to fund
RESOLVED to recommend we apply for an Awards for all Grant with the Lottery for £10,000 and look to purchase a variety of outdoor gym equipment. Clerk to obtain quotes and then apply once Full Council approve.

- c) Flooring replacement under the youth cover
 The Clerk has spoken with a contractor who has recommended a concrete floor (3mx3m) they have suggested it would be around £1,000. Clerk to obtain quotes.

- d) Play equipment and fence painting
 Clerk to contact SDDC to ask when they are intending to paint the equipment/fencing and report back. If SDDC are not intending to paint anytime soon Clerk will obtain quotes for the painting of the youth hut, fence and play equipment.

 Clerk to investigate quotes for replacing the paved footpath and Cllr Hobson to arrange some volunteers to re plant some of the area (once the footpath is fixed), Clerk to also check ownership.
